Multi-Sport Facilities New Construction

Case Studies

Lytchett Minster School

5,000m² of sand-dressed artificial turf and a 4 bay fully enclosed cricket coaching area. This project is located amongst picturesque woodland therefore the layout, landscaping and design had to be considerate of existing trees. Excavations from the site have been used to form a viewing embankment in keeping with the site's existing contoured surrounds.



Reading Borough Council – Prospect Park

This project involved converting a poorly drained playing field into five independent 5-a-side courts totalling 3,000m². S&C Slatter were responsible for the entire build including fencing, floodlighting and access pathways. The new Artificial Turf Pitches, primarily used for football, are surfaced with a 3G, sand and rubber crumb-filled, synthetic grass. This is one of a number of projects S&C Slatter have carried out for Reading Borough Council.



St. Philip and St. James C of E Primary School

This school is located on an ancient burial ground, so no excavation below existing levels was allowed. Preparation involved killing surface vegetation, stabilising the existing soil through extensive rolling and installation of a free draining granular stone base above the existing levels. This was surfaced with a specialist geo-textile and a durable sand-filled needle punched Artificial Turf surface, to create a multi-functional facility.



Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead - Braywick Park

This facility is run by the Local Authority for community use on a site also used by Maidenhead Rugby Club. The two floodlit 5-a-side courts, surfaced with a 3G long-piled sand and rubber filled surface, formed part of a contract to install facilities at both Windsor Leisure Centre and at Braywick Park. Kevin Mist, Head of Leisure Services said, "We found S&C Slatter Ltd to be a very good organisation to do business with, always co-operative, friendly and efficient in their contract execution."



Blandford St. Mary Primary School

A 534m² Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA) was constructed working with principal contractor, Snibor Ltd, as part of major building works at the school. The facility is used for a cross section of sports and school activities. It is a particularly valuable teaching resource as the site has limited natural turf sports fields, following the large extension to the school.



Bracknell Town Council - Nettlecombe Estate

An open access public play space, which was previously a mud bath throughout the winter, was converted to a dry and practical multi-activity surface using a durable hardwearing sand-filled surface. We were able to advise on the most suitable surface to ensure a high resistance to wear and tear in this unsupervised location. As part of the project new heavy-duty goals and short runs of ball stop fencing were installed.



Surfaces

As an independent construction company we have access to materials from some of Europe's leading surface suppliers. Broadly speaking there are three main types of synthetic grass:



Sand-filled; typically needle-punched or tufted construction, when the complete pile of the fabric is fully supported by the sand filling.



Sand-dressed; usually a denser piled fabric, tufted or woven, with a fine dressing of sand to support the base of the pile.



3G (3rd Generation); filled with a mix of sand and rubber or purely rubber, usually a longer pile.
